In addition to language instruction, Mina Seminole and Linwood Tallbull provide fascinating history, information on plants, herbs and tribal healing. Thus, the class will be of interest to those of you who are already fluent Cheyenne speakers.

To encourage more attendance, the date and time of the time of the class is being changed to Tuesday from 8:15 a.m. – 9:00 a.m. in the Tribal Council chambers. This will be a good way to start the day. Lynwood Tallbull, THPO is also looking at getting some incentives and rewards for people who attend the class. The best reward, however, will be learning to speak our language. I hope to see you there.
