NOTICE OF SPECIAL GENERAL ELECTION TO FILL VACANCY IN OFFICE OF TRIBAL PRESIDENT

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN AS FOLLOWS:

1. **No Primary Election.** Only two persons timely filed Declarations of Candidacy for President, to fill the vacancy in the position of Tribal President arising from the Tribal Council's removal of Eugene Little Coyote as Tribal President. Accordingly, as provided in the Tribe's Election Ordinance, no primary election will be held and the Tribe will proceed directly to a general election as described below.

2. **General Election.** On Thursday, February 28, 2008, a Tribal general election will be held in all Districts of the Northern Cheyenne Reservation, to elect a Tribal President who will serve until the November 2008 regular Tribal elections.

3. **Time and Place to Vote.** For the general election, the polls in all Districts will be open from approximately 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m., and will be located as follows:

Ashland Community Hall

Birney

Elderly Center (Old Catholic Church)

Busby

Northern Cheyenne Tribal School Cafeteria

Lame Deer

Little Wolf Capitol Building -- Tribal Council Chambers

4. **Who May Vote.** All Tribal members aged 18 or older on the day of the general election, who are on his/her District's Voters List, and properly register on the day of the general election at his/her District polling place or

properly apply for and obtain an absentee ballot, will be entitled to vote in the general election.

5. **Final Candidates, Write-In Voting.** The final candidates for President are listed below. Because there will be no primary election, write-in voting will be permitted. Each voter may vote for one candidate only.
