The Northern Cheyenne Tribe (N.C.T.) is now accepting bids for Monitoring Site Relocation Services for the Department of Environmental Protection and Natural Resources located on the Northern Cheyenne Tribal Reservation, Lame Deer, Montana.

The Contractor shall furnish all labor, equipment, and material needed to complete the project as requested by the N.C.T. This bid should include (but is not limited to) the following:

SCOPE OF WORK:

The scope of work would be to clear all trees, roots and debris for the new sites,
To remove all materials from the old site.

To construct the new platform (8"x16', off the ground 3'), steps and railing for the steps.

To install an electrical box on the platform with one outlet for power for the air monitoring equipment.

To set a new concrete base (at least one yard for base) for the meteorological tower with the base plate and at least three guy wires.

To install an 8' chain link fence around the platform and this includes one 4'-8' gate at one end, preferably near the steps,

To assistance in moving the air monitoring equipment to the new site (this includes the tower, TEOM and precipitation gage).

This work should be completed in 3-5 days.

Emailed or faxed proposals will not be allowed and late proposals will not be considered. All Required documents must be in the sealed bid prior to opening.** Bid opening will be June 2, 2017 at 10:00 a.m. No bids may be withdrawn after the scheduled time for the public opening of bids.
