Sealed bids for the construction of Sludge Removal Services will be received by the Procurement Office of Northern Cheyenne Tribe until 11:00 am October 20, 2017.

The project consists generally of sludge from cell 2 of the Lame Deer Wastewater Treatment facility and land application of the sludge at an agricultural site approximately 8 miles east of the facility.

Contractor and any of the Contractor's Subcontractors do work on this project are required to obtain registration with the Montana Department of Labor and Industry (DLI). Forms for registration are available from the Department of Labor and Industry, P.O. Box 8011, 1805 Prospect, Helena, Montana 59604-8011. Information on registration can be obtained by calling (406) 444-7734. Contractor is required to have registered with the DLI prior to bidding on this project. All workers employed by Contractor or subcontractors in performance of the construction work shall be paid wages at rates as may be required by the laws of the State of Montana and the Northern Cheyenne Tribe. The Contractor is required to comply with the requirements of the Northern Cheyenne Tribal Employment Rights Office (TERO), for information call (406) 477-6287. The Contractor must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of their race, color, religion, sex or national origin. Each bid or proposal must be accompanied by a Certified Check, Cashier's check, or Bid Bond payable to the Northern Cheyenne Tribe, in an amount not less than ten percent (10%) of the total amount of the bid. Successful Bidders shall furnish an approved Performance Bond and a Labor and Materials Payment Bond, each in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the contract amount. Insurance as required shall be proved by the successful Bidder(s) and a certificate(s) of that insurance shall be provided. This project is funded in part or in whole with funding from Indian Health Service. Award of this project will be contingent upon receiving funding and award occurrence from the above stated agencies.

No bid may be withdrawn after the scheduled time for the public opening of bids, which is 11:00 am, October 20, 2017.

The right is reserved to reject any or all proposals received, to waive informalities, to postpone the award of the contract for a period of not to exceed sixty (60) days, and to accept the lowest responsive and responsible bid which is in the best interest of the Owner.
